- Theologically and philosophically aligned with Village Church leadership
- Continual development in the form of personal reading and outside training
- Faithful in marriage and families as applicable
- A contagious passion for developing disciples through intentional communities
- Has a servant heart
- Theological training
- Experience in leading Community Groups, recruiting, inspiring, and coaching leaders. Experience in multi-site or larger church is preferred but not essential
- Excellence in writing quality, relevant group discussion questions from a weekly sermon
- Ability to adapt past training and experience into Village culture and needs
- Thrives in a rapidly changing environment and is able to adjust to changing job roles
- Professional level skills and experience in system organization
- Proven success at multi-tasking, time management, and prioritization

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Strategize with Discipleship Pastor to implement three-year discipleship trajectory for Intentional Community Groups
- Develop weekly sermon-based community group discussion and study questions
- Produce a weekly community group video-based and written discussion guide
- Develop and maintain an accurate website presence/description of active groups and those with openings
- Create and initiate 3-4 effective community group on-ramps throughout the year across our sites and in consultation with Site Pastors



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- Coordinate effective interface between Alpha and Freedom Session groups, Intentional Community Groups, Missional Groups, and Village Triads
- Research/approve any outside curriculum used in Village Community groups
- Liaison with Pastor of Counseling in the implementation of recommended Village support or specialty groups
- Liaison with Site Pastors to identify and train Intentional Community and Missional Group leaders
- Establish and maintain quality control of Community Group experiences and training
- Ensure effective pastoral care through community groups and Site Pastors
- Liaison with local and global mission for missional opportunities
- Develop and implement a plan to monitor Community Group attendance, health, and missional focus
- Work with Village Site and Discipleship Pastors to practice strategic (in home) hospitality initiatives on Sunday mornings to welcome/assimilate those new to Village Church
- Takes ownership of inviting new people to serve on a regular (weekly) basis and then teaching other volunteers how to do the same
- Committed to thanking at least one volunteer on a weekly basis
- Intentional in pursuing relationships with unchurched people

KEY RESULTS

- Community Groups will become an obvious and understood "next step" connection point for new attenders of Village Church.
- We will have a clear and effective Village Community Group assimilation process communicated on-line and at our various on-site locations. The purposes and relationship of the different types of Village Communities (gospel, intentional, missional, triads, women's, etc.) is clear. Site Pastors are inspired/empowered to assimilate people into Village Communities.
- Quality and creative sermon-based Community Group curriculum (written and video) are created and delivered weekly to community group leaders.
- Community Group leaders are recruited, trained, and inspired to evaluate the spiritual maturity
 of group members and teach them the disciplines of a mature follower of Jesus over a three year
 period
- Additional CG leadership training modules are created, captured, and catalogued in a Village Church online library
- We will witness a 50% of our weekly adult attendance participating in Village (traditional) Community Groups within 2 years and an overall participation of 70% of adult attendance in recognized Village Community (includes FS, Alpha, Triads)
- Effective systems to monitor Village Community attendance, health, wins and challenges are developed and maintained.
